

An image of the cervix appears.






Note all of the tools at the top of the screen. Anyone who is familiar with using most any graphics editor will be able to use these to draw lines, shapes, add text, etc., just as you would in those programs. If you hover the mouse cursor over the tool icon, a popup will tell you what that tool will do. With a little trial & error, you'll be able to do any annotation you feel necessary.





You can scroll through a number of useful stock images. Here we'll open one called **face.bmp**.



Here we've drawn & labeled a laceration, & saved the image with the name **Facial lac**.

Note that you can also browse to images that you have on the computer desktop, or elsewhere, such as on the hard drive or a USB thumb drive. NextGen can import most common image types, such as BMP & JPG.

You can also import PDF files in this manner, which comes in handy if you want to save a PDF document to the encounter.

If the computer is hooked up to a scanner, paper images can also be scanned into NextGen. While this can be done through the Image Module, most commonly this will be done by designated staff members using another tool, the Image Control System. In this way, any drawing, form, letter, report, or other item received on paper can be saved to a specific encounter on the NextGen chart.
